Terms and Conditions of Participation

The Marie-Vincent Motorcycle Tour is a benefit trek to help child victims of maltreatment and sexual abuse in Québec.

Participation Fees - Donations

You must be willing to collect a minimum of \$300 in donations in order to participate in the Marie-Vincent Motorcycle Tour.

An amount of \$45 per person must be added on to cover the cost of 3 group meals scheduled throughout the event. This amount is non-refundable.

Participation fees and meal fees must be received before Friday, April 30th 2010.

Income Tax Receipt

To claim a tax receipt for donations amounting to more than \$20/person you must make sure the donator has indicated so by checking the proper space on the donation form.

Cash Donations

For cash donations, we recommend you deposit the money in your personal Motorcycle Tour account and issue us a cheque for the total amount of donations you have received. **There is no limit to the amount of donations, in fact you may collect donations up until the date at which the event is being held – August 10th 2010.**

Deadline

To register in the Motorcycle Tour, you must send in by mail your duly signed participation form and payment (\$300 + \$45) no later than April 30th 2010. Your registration will be confirmed upon receipt of the participation form and payment and a participant's number will be assigned to you. Please note that all related costs during the Motorcycle Tour such as lodging, meals, gas and other personal costs are at the participant's expense.

Information Session

An information session will be held in Longueuil in June of 2010. Participants will receive all relevant details pertaining to the Tour, a very useful safety guide and a complete Motorcycle Tour Package. They will also learn all about safety and riding procedures in a convoy. **The information session is mandatory and free of charge.**

Responsibility

The Marie-Vincent Foundation, its administrators, personnel and volunteers assume no responsibility for damages, material loss or bodily injury that may occur, through negligence or otherwise during the Motorcycle Tour. As a participant you are made aware of the risks incurred and accept full and complete responsibility. Your motorcycle and equipment must be in order and in compliance with the law.
